Local Area Analysts

Data on specific counties or substate areas in New Jersey may be obtained from the Labor Planning and Analysis' two regional Labor Market Information (LMI) centers. A list of labor market analysts assigned to specific geographic areas of responsibility and map of New Jersey labor areas is found on page 10. Page 11 provides a list of these local area analysts by county of responsibility, analysts' phone numbers and the addresses of the LMI centers.

New Jersey State Data Center

Housed within the Office of Labor Planning and Analysis is the New Jersey State Data Center (NJSDC). The NJSDC is a federal-state cooperative program between the US Bureau of the Census and the state of New Jersey. The NJSDC's objectives are to increase access to, awareness of, use of and expertise in census data and related products. NJSDC publications are listed under "Population and US Census" on pages 6 and 7.

Center for Occupational Employment Information

Also housed within the Office of Labor Planning and Analysis is the Center for Occupational Employment Information (COEI). COEI is an interagency consortium of the New Jersey Departments of Labor, Education, Community Affairs and Human Services, as well as the Commerce and Economic Growth Commission, the Commission on Higher Education and the State Employment and Training Commission. The COEI is mandated to provide accurate and timely occupational and career development information and to improve coordination, cooperation and communication between state agencies in the development of a comprehensive New Jersey Occupational Information System. COEI publications are listed under "Career Planning" on page 7. The COEI's Career Information Hotline phone number is provided on page 12.

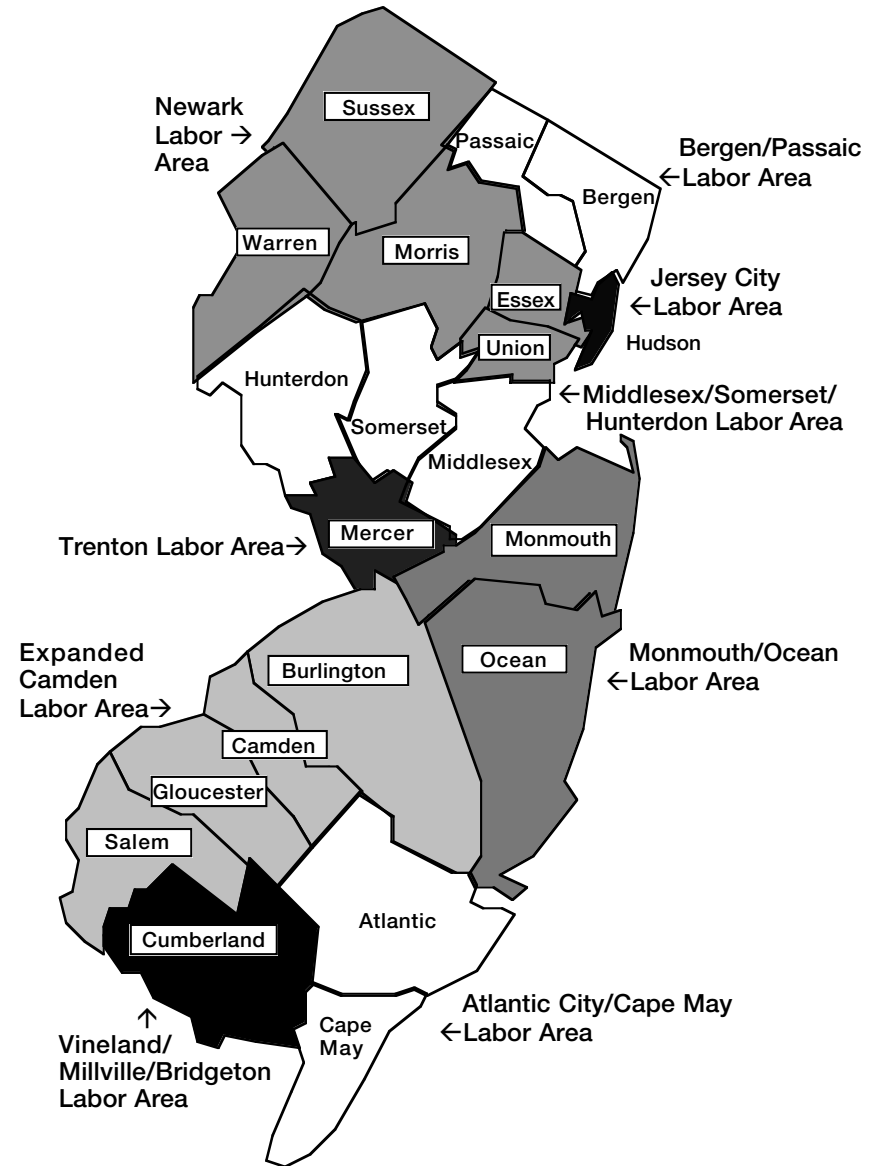
